

**CRIME ALERT:  
STOLEN VEHICLE CONTAINING CONTRACTOR IDENTIFICATION**

**Eden Prairie, Minn.** — Earlier this week, the Minneapolis Police Department received a report of a stolen vehicle belonging to an employee of the SL-Serco company. SL-Serco, a utility service contractor, was hired by the City of Eden Prairie to conduct residential sump pump inspections related to the City's Inflow and Infiltration program.

The stolen vehicle is a 2000 green Dodge Dakota pick-up truck with Minnesota license plates 472-BLM. Items inside the stolen vehicle include SL-serco magnets, an SL-serco winter jacket, a safety vest, and a photo ID belonging to the SL-serco employee who had been driving the vehicle.

Eden Prairie's Inflow and Infiltration program is scheduled to continue through the end of the year; however, only homeowners who have received official written notification directly from the City of Eden Prairie should expect to receive a visit from an SL-serco representative.

As general practice, Eden Prairie Police recommend that residents confirm the legitimacy of any contractor attempting to gain access to a home before allowing them inside, and call 911 immediately to report suspicious incidents or individuals.
