

# Rowland Road Signal Analysis

A traffic signal warrant analysis was conducted to determine if a traffic signal is needed. The analysis considers:

- new traffic generators
- future traffic volumes
- crash susceptibility
- potential for severe crashes
- pedestrian access

A signal is not recommended because:

- Traffic operations will be acceptable without a signal
- Traffic volumes are not high enough to warrant a signal
- Hennepin County ranking analysis score of 3 (threshold is 30)

Installing unwarranted signals can cause problems such as increased delays and crashes. Signals are a worthy public investment when warranted, but they are also expensive to construct, operate and maintain.

The project will be constructed to allow space for a future traffic signal, should the need for one arise later due to unforeseen traffic changes.
