

City of Eden Prairie Adopt-a-Street Terms and Conditions

1. The group agrees to pick up litter on a segment of a City street selected in consultation with the Adopt-A-Street Coordinator. At the City's discretion, certain streets may not be eligible.
2. The group shall review the Adopt-A-Street Safety document before each pick-up to alert participants to the hazards and precautions of working on street right-of-way.
3. The group shall pick up litter during daylight hours only. Pick-ups may not be allowed at certain times such as on or near holidays.
4. The group shall provide adequate supervision to participants eighteen years of age or younger. Unless specifically permitted, children eleven or younger shall not participate.
5. The group shall have a minimum of three participants at any time during the litter pick-up event.
6. Work shall be limited to that portion of the street right-of-way not designated as traffic or parking lane.
7. The group shall arrange litter pick-up date(s) in advance with the Adopt-A-Street Coordinator. The group shall obtain their supplies during regular business hours between 7:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Groups are encouraged to recycle appropriate materials for their own benefit
8. The group shall wear high visibility vests at all times during the litter pick-up event.
9. The group agrees to pick up litter twice a year between March 1st and November 1st.

The City of Eden Prairie agrees to:

1. Provide trash bags, high visibility vests and Adopt-A-Street Safety document.
2. Arrange to remove filled trash bags after notification of location(s) of bag(s).
3. Arrange to remove large, heavy or hazardous material from the adopted street.
4. Annually recognize the group's clean-up efforts in the City's Life in the Prairie insert in the Eden Prairie News and Facebook.
