
1. Roadway Construction

 - c. Water main along southbound Shady Oak Road
 - d. Permanent signal systems
 - e. Lighting along the southeast ramp
 - f. Turf establishment

 - a. Beam setting

 - f. Turf establishment

3. Traffic Control/Detours

- a. The entrance ramp to westbound Hwy. 212 will remain closed through Wednesday, Sept. 23.
- b. The exit ramp from eastbound Hwy. 212 is scheduled to be closed for approximately 28 days beginning at 4 a.m. Monday, Sept. 28.
- c. Daytime temporary lane closures are anticipated on Hwy. 212 to facilitate bridge construction. Lane closures for westbound Hwy. 212 may occur between 6 a.m. and 3 p.m. Lane closures for eastbound Hwy. 212 may occur between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m.
- d. Bridge beams will be placed Saturday, Sept. 19. This will include a temporary closure of Hwy. 212.
 - i. Eastbound Hwy. 212 will be reduced to one lane and traffic and will be diverted to the exit/entrance ramps beginning at 5 p.m. Traffic will be controlled by the signal at Shady Oak Road, this will remain in place until approximately midnight Sept. 19.
 - ii. Due to the entrance ramp closure, traffic on westbound Hwy. 212 will be detoured to westbound Hwy. 62 and southbound Hwy. 494. The detour will begin at approximately 11 p.m. and remain in place until approximately 6 a.m. Sunday, Sept. 20.
 - iii. Shady Oak Road will remain open to traffic.
