1. Roadway Construction

- a. Curb and pavement removals in the Southwest Transit parking lot
- b. Preliminary pond grading and storm sewer installation
- c. Permanent signal systems
- d. Temporary barrier installation along Highway 212

3. Traffic Control/Detours

- a. Beginning Monday, April 11, Shady Oak Road will be reduced to one lane in each direction from City West Parkway north intersection to 1000 feet east of Flying Cloud Drive. This is necessary to complete work in the median. The lane closure is expected to be in place for approximately four to six weeks.
- b. Northbound Shady Oak Road, between Flying Cloud Drive and the Highway 212 east ramps will be closed from 7 a.m. Saturday, April 16, through 8 p.m. Sunday, April 17. Traffic will be detoured south on Flying Cloud Drive to Valley View Road onto eastbound Highway 212. Southbound Shady Oak Road will remain open.
- c. A temporary barrier has been placed along Highway 212 to complete the concrete slope paving under the bridge.
- d. Daytime temporary lane closures are anticipated on Highway 212 to complete bridge construction (concrete placement and painting). Lane closures for westbound Highway 212 may occur between 6 a.m. and 3 p.m. Lane closures for eastbound Highway 212 may occur between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m.
