Aspire Eden Prairie 2040


n 2017, Eden Prairie launched the planning process to update its Comprehensive Plan called Aspire Eden Prairie 2040.

Feedback from residents and stakeholders, along with information gathered from housing and transportation studies, are informing a draft of the plan, which will be presented to the City Council for review this spring.

Watch for your opportunity to review the plan and provide additional feedback before the City submits the final draft to the Metropolitan Council for approval later this year.

n March, residential property owners receive a Hennepin County 2018 Property Tax Statement based on the 2017 assessment indicating taxes due this year, and a 2018 Notice of Valuation and Classification indicating property values used as a basis for taxes due in 2019.

The City's Assessing Division maintains Eden Prairie property records and adjusts the market values based on actual real estate sales on comparable properties from the past year.

Thursday, April 12. Families, neighborhoods and businesses are encouraged to review and practice emergency plans in preparation for the upcoming severe weather season.

Recreational Fire Guidelines

General recreational fire guidelines in Eden Prairie include:

- Maximum size of 3-by-3 feet
- Must be at least 25 feet from any combustible structures such as homes, sheds, decks or fences
- Only wood with minimum 1-inch diameter may be burned
- Fires permitted between 7 a.m. and midnight
- Fires allowed when wind is less than 15 miles per hour
- Any fire or police officer may withdraw permission for recreational fires

A copy of Eden Prairie's detailed recreational fire guidelines, available online or from the **Fire Department**, serves as your permit and must be on-site.

Water Quality





Watershed Assessment Project

Wenck Associates, Inc., the City is conducting a multiyear project to survey stormwater ponds and wetlands. These water bodies help prevent flooding and collect pollutants such as fertilizers, pet waste and grass clippings, and can require maintenance over time.

This year, the City will assess the Round Lake watershed and develop a plan to address future maintenance needs.


