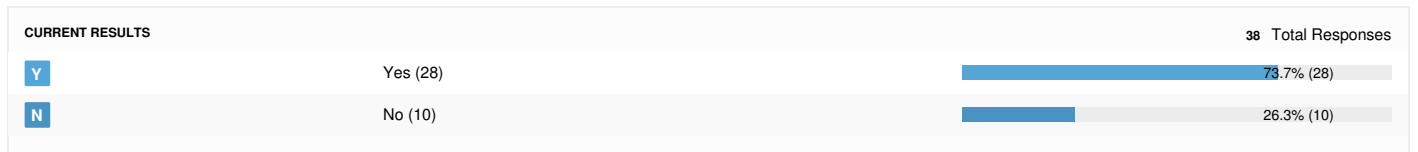


Is there an adequate supply of different housing types in the community?
