

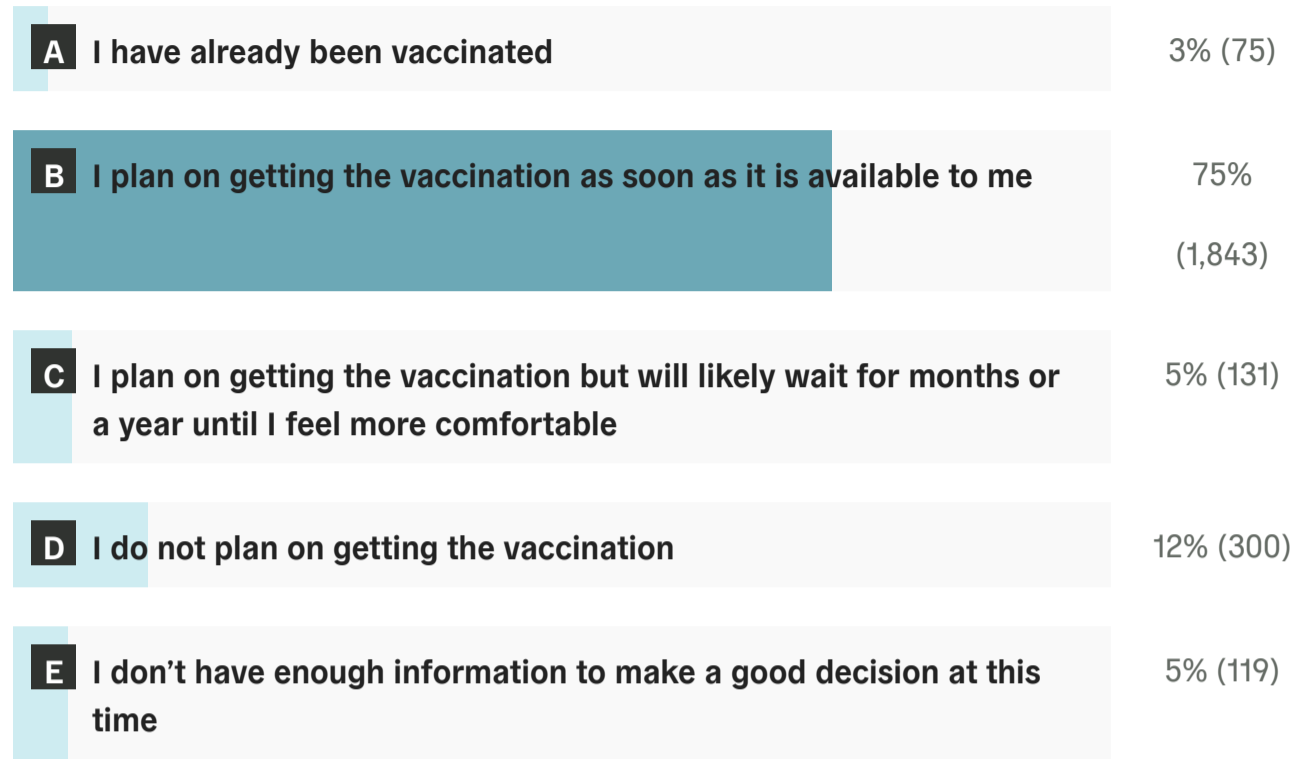

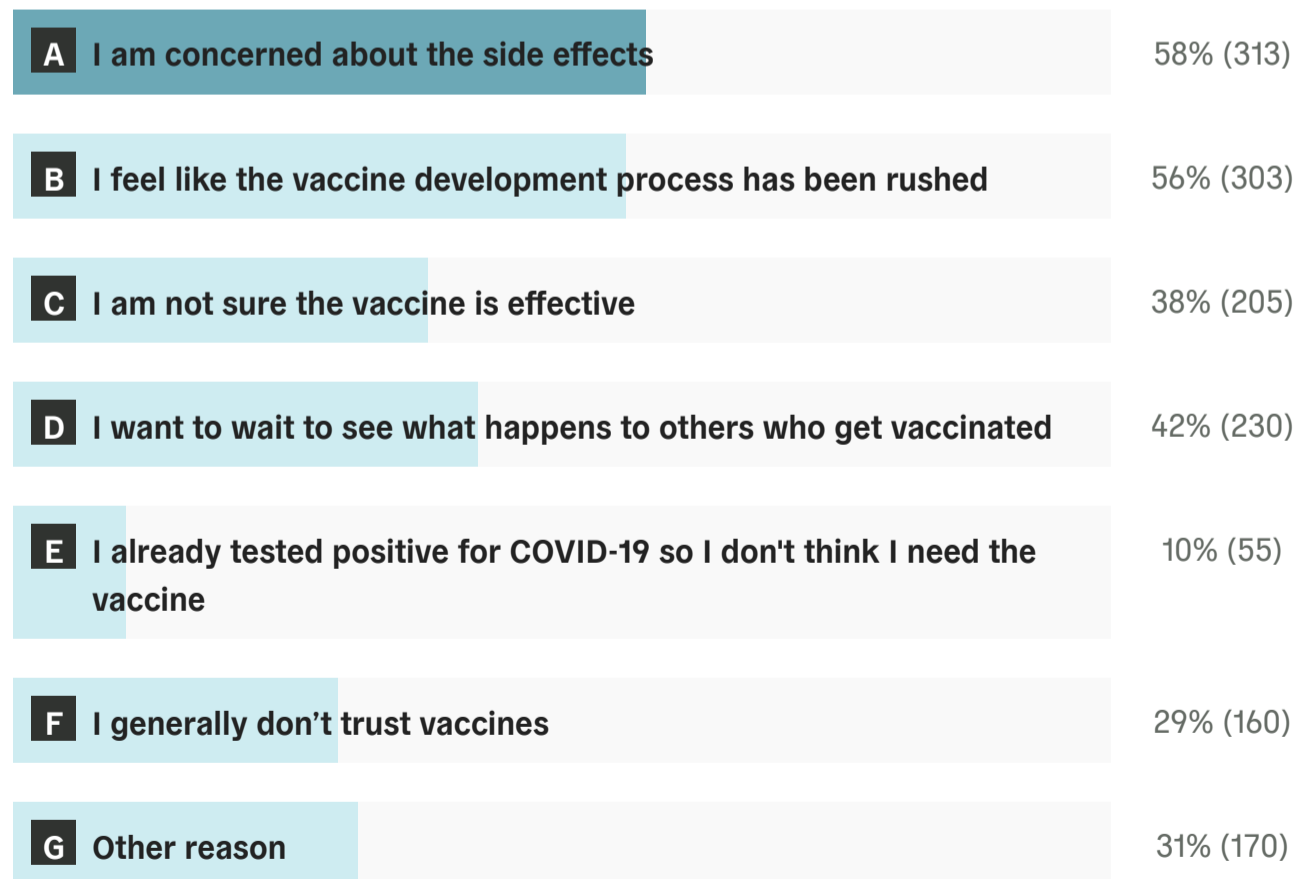

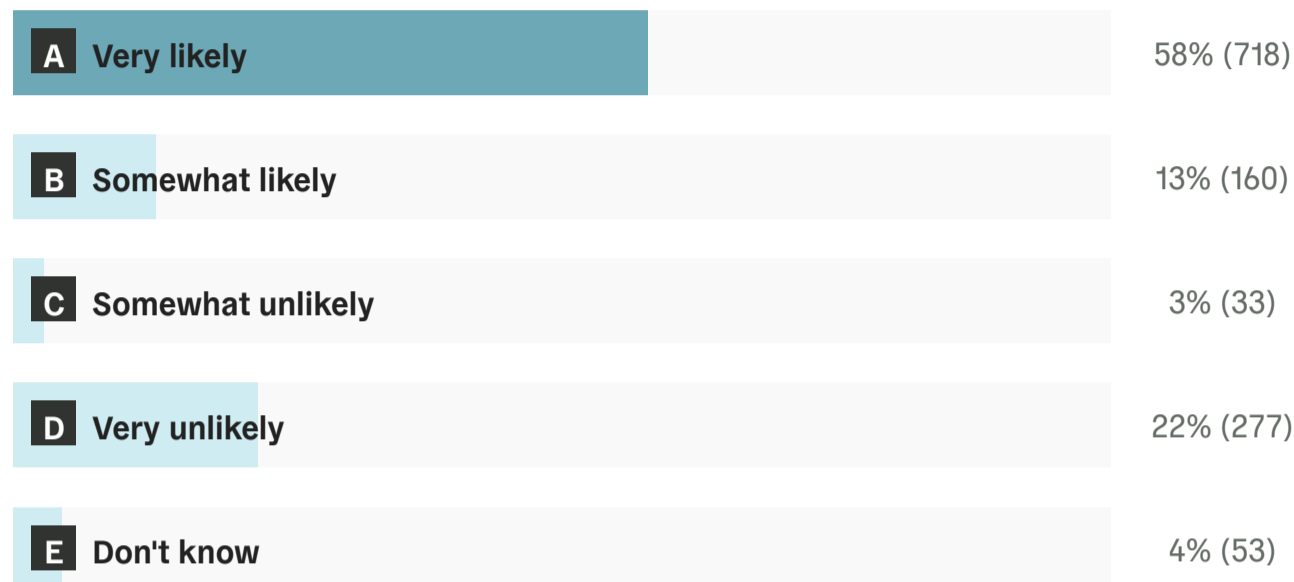

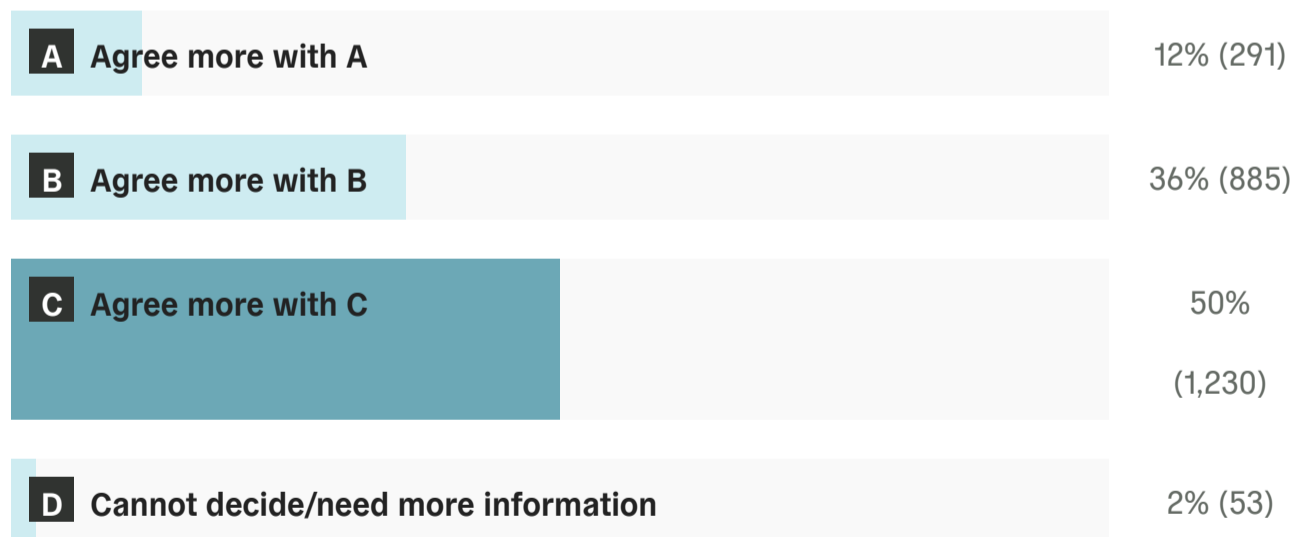

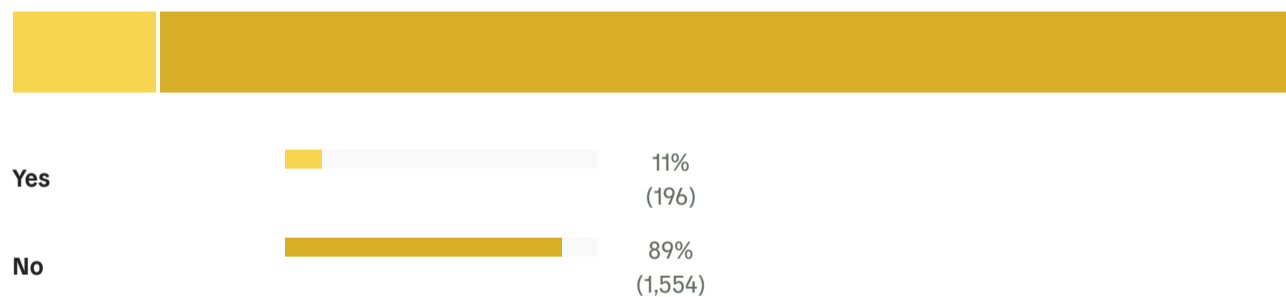

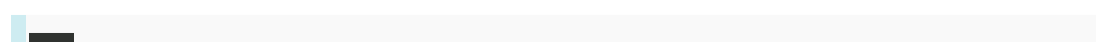

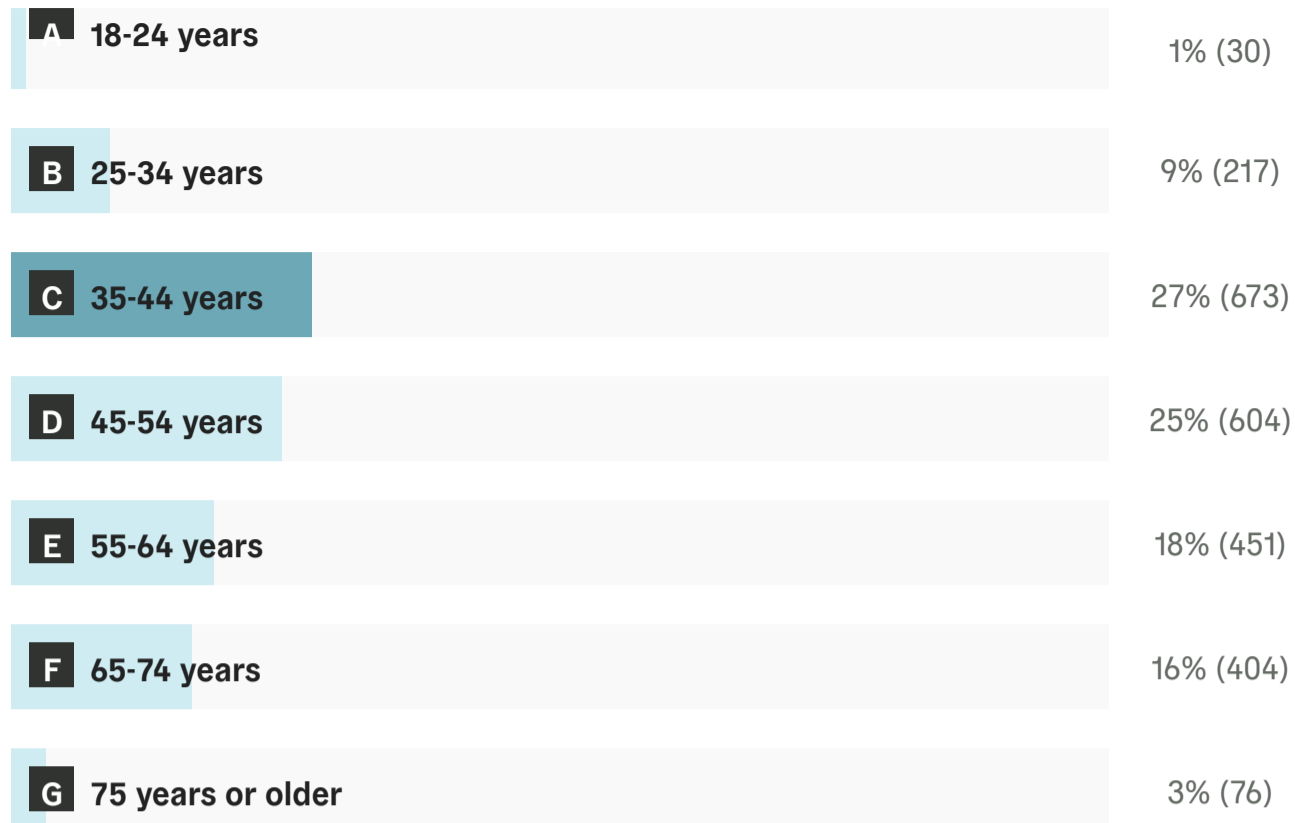

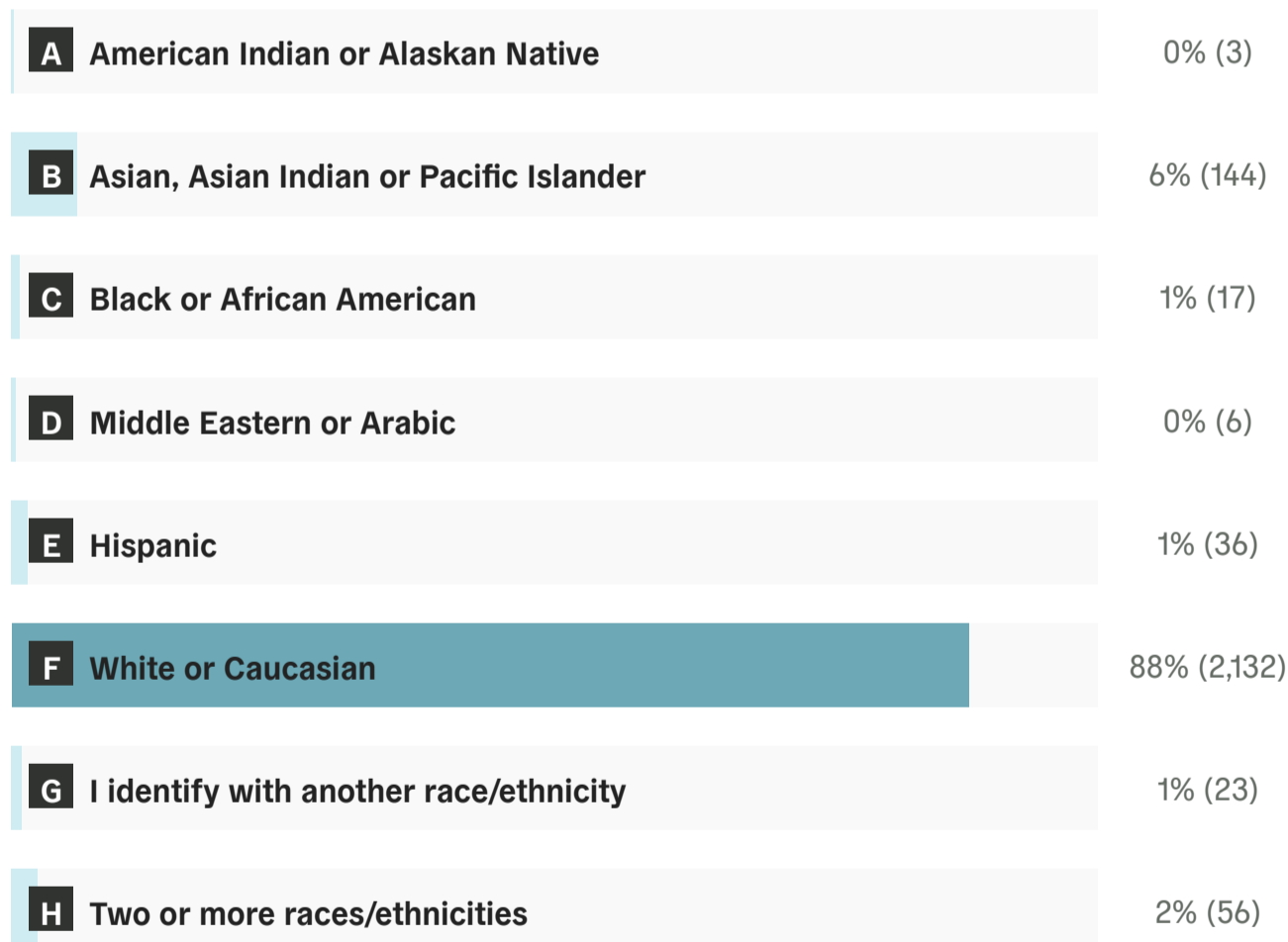


In which category is your age?



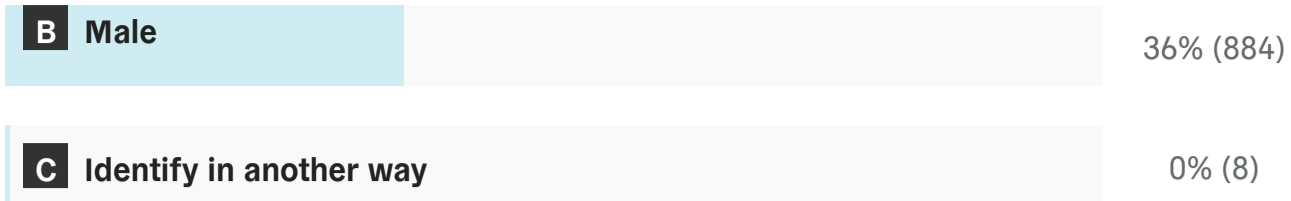


Which of the categories below best describes your racial/ethnic identity?

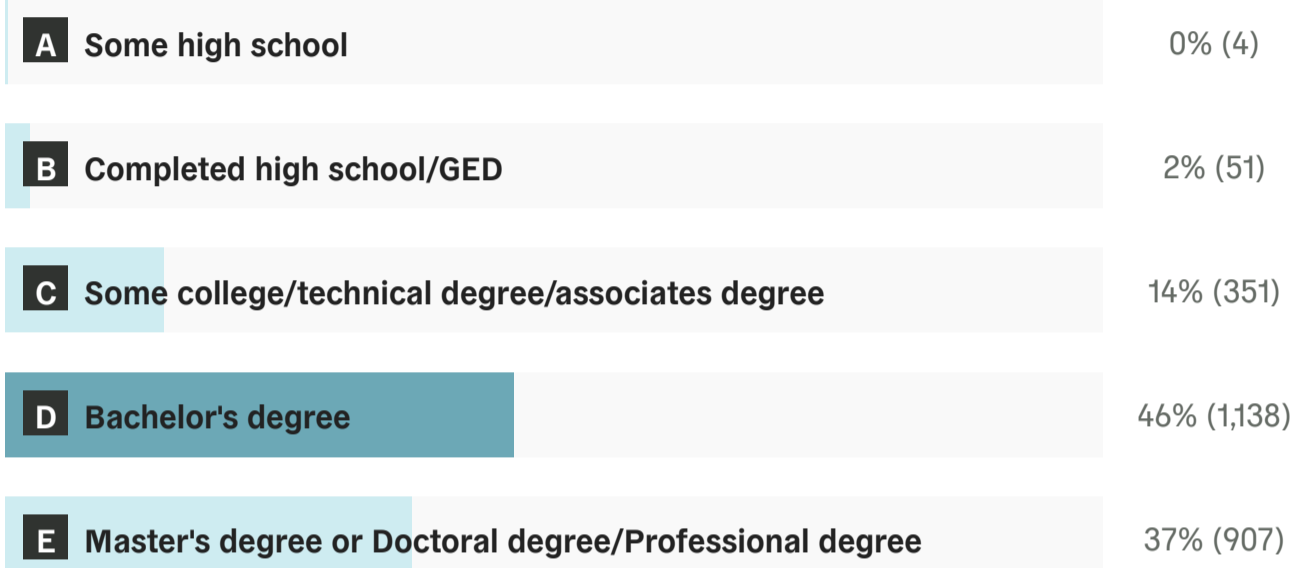


What is your gender?
