Homes built prior to the mid-'80s in the City of Eden Prairie did not require a Certificate of Survey. A Certificate of Survey is now required for new home construction to accurately verify setbacks and easements. If an existing property does not have a Certificate of Survey on file when applying for a building permit for a proposed addition, garage, deck or other structure, the property owner has the option of hiring an engineering or surveying company to create a new Certificate of Survey for the property or the owner can file an Absence of Certificate of Survey application. Use this example and the attached form as a guide to help prepare the Absence of Certificate of Survey application. Contact the Planning Division if you have questions about completing this application.

What is a Site Plan?

A Site Plan is a plan drawn to scale showing the uses and structures proposed for a specific parcel of land.

A Site Plan should include the following information:

- 1. Property lines with dimensions.
- 2. Location of all existing and proposed structures.
- 3. Location of all existing easements.
- Exterior dimensions of all existing and proposed structures, with dimensions to property lines.
- 5. Name, address and phone number of the property owner.
- 6. Address of the construction site.
- 7. North arrow and scale.


